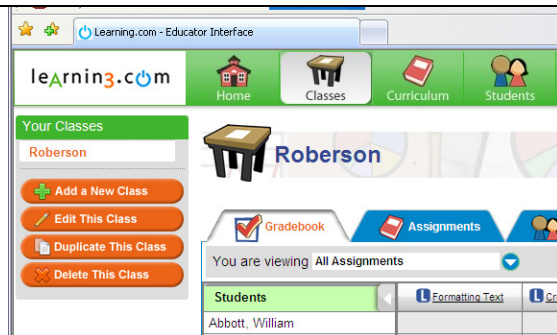
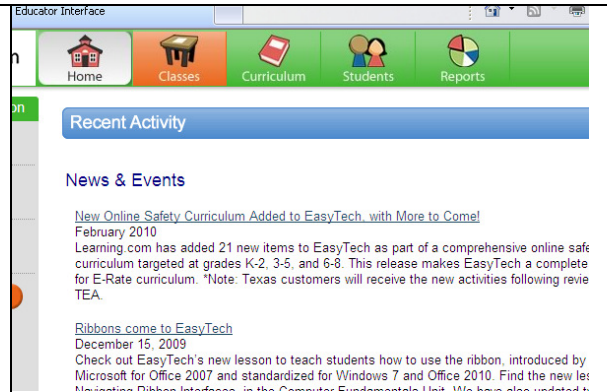


Setting a Percentage for Passing an EasyTech Lesson


If you want kids to pass the Easy Tech Lessons at a certain percentage before they go on to the next one you have to set up your class that way. You can either do this when you first set up your class or you can edit it later.

After logging in choose Classes



After clicking on the class you want choose "Edit this Class" from the left side.

When the window to edit your class appears change the percentage at the bottom to what you want it to be and choose forced rather than open for Assignment Sequence. Now students will not be able to go on to another lesson until they pass that lesson at the percentage you chose.
