



Comic Life

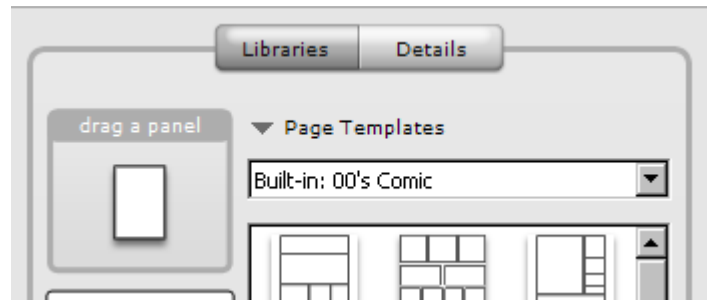


1. Launch *Comic Life*. The window will be blank.

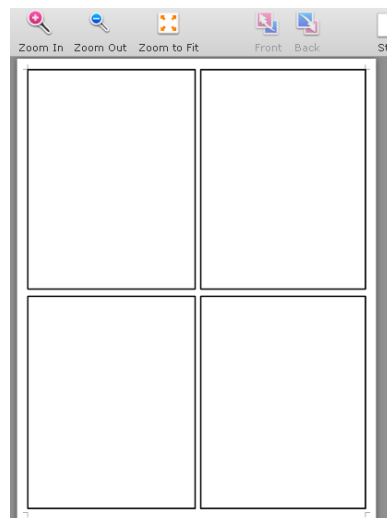


2. Choose a *Page Template* and drag it onto the blank window.

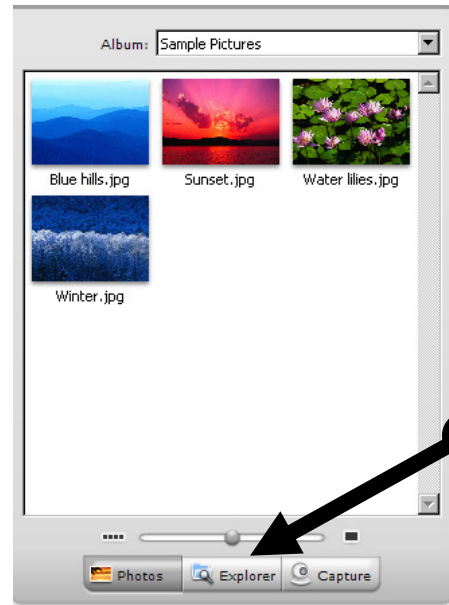
Note the pulldown menu holds many more *Page Templates*.



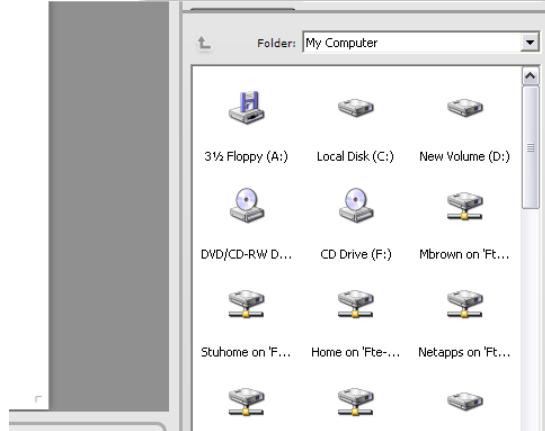
3. This is now your Page Template layout.



4. Click on *Explorer* and then navigate to the folder where your pictures are.



4 a. Use the drop down menu and choose My Computer . Then open your home folder and navigate to your pictures.



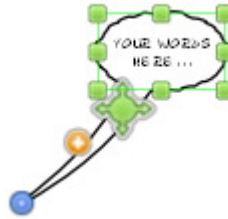
4b. You can also copy and paste pictures and clip art from websites.



5. Choose a balloon style and drag it to the *Page Template*.

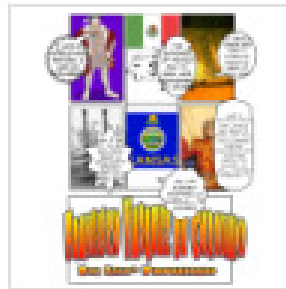


6. Size the balloon with the green handles. You can drag the blue handle to guide it toward the speaker's mouth. Double click the balloon to add your text.



7. You can print your comic. If you want to share it electronically, save it as a *PDF*, or export it as a jpg.
