







# Inspiration

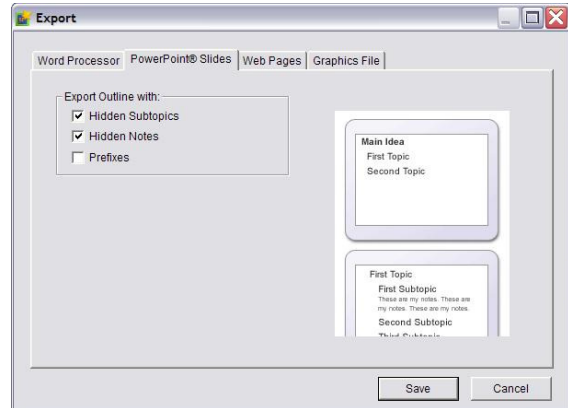
<p>1. Launch Inspiration. 2. Type "All About Me" in the <b>Main Idea</b> bubble.</p>	
<p>3. Click off of the bubble and then back on it. 4. Click on <b>RapidFire</b>. You will notice that a lightening bolt appears after the word "me".</p>	
<p>5. Type your first category: <b>hobbies</b>. You need not position the cursor. Simply begin to type. When you have entered the desired text, click <b>Enter</b> and what you typed will appear as a link to the <b>Main Idea</b>. 6. Continue adding the following links in this manner: <b>pets, family, education</b>.</p>	
<p>7. Click <b>Arrange</b> and choose <b>Tree</b>.</p>	
<p>8. Highlight bubbles whose colors and font size you'd like to change. Make selections in the <b>Text</b> menu and the <b>Effect: Fill Color</b> menu. 9. To get your diagram to fit to the size of your computer window, press <b>Control/E</b> on Windows and <b>Apple/E</b> on Macs.</p>	
<p>10. You can add pictures by clicking on the symbol palette and typing a key word into the search box. If you can't see the <b>Symbol Palette</b>, press the <b>F8</b> key on your keyboard. 11. When you find the picture that you want, click on the idea bubble and then click on the symbol. 12. After you have a picture for each of the idea bubbles, you will have to arrange your graphic organizer again.</p>	

# Exporting to Power Point

1. Click on the **Outline** button, which is the icon on the far left. This is a very important step and must be done in order for you to export.



2. Go to **File: Export**.  
3. In the pop-up screen, choose the **PowerPoint Slides** option.  
4. Save it to the desktop.



5. Minimize Inspiration and open the new document by clicking on the **Power Point** icon that is now on the desktop.
