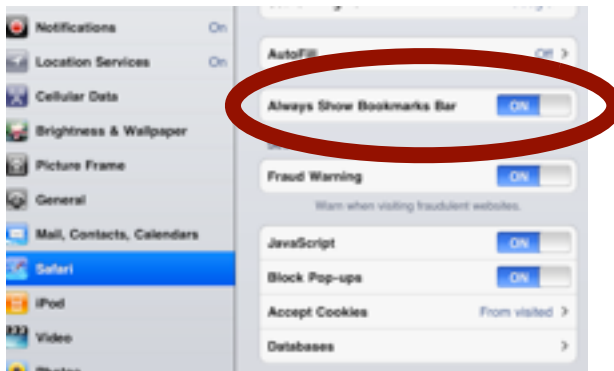


How to make an ePub on an iPad from content found on the Web.

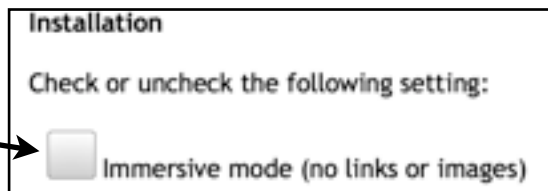
*Be sure "Always Show Bookmark Bar" is turned "ON" in the Safari Settings



1. Visit the following site: <http://dotepub.com/>

dotEPUB is software in the cloud that allows you to convert any webpage into an e-book.

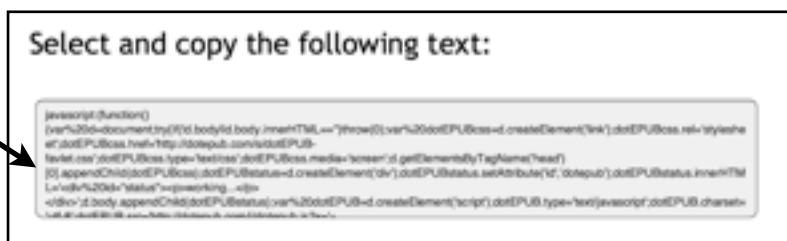
2. Be sure to uncheck the following setting:



Immersive mode:

In the immersive mode, links will be removed, you will not be offered the possibility of keeping images and there will be no indication where removed images and videos were.

3. Select and Copy the javascript text from the <http://dotepub.com/> site



4. Press  in the Safari toolbar, then **Add bookmark** to Bookmarks Bar, rename it to dotEPUB (or to one of your choice) and **Save**.

5. Open your bookmarks, select **Bookmarks Bar** and press **Edit**. Select the dotEPUB bookmark and then remove the **URL** (web address) by tapping (X) and paste the previously selected text in its place.



6. Try it: Visit an article webpage you want to save or transfer to your e-reader as an e-book. Just press the **dotEPUB** bookmark in your browser's toolbar.
