Open iMovie on your iPad —
Select project to be rendered /exported



Select:  To Export

- 1st Export project
- 2nd Select **Camera Roll**

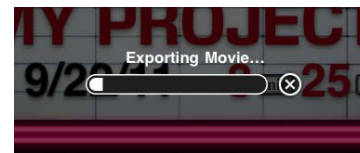


Select **Medium – 360p**










Allow program to export movie. This will take a moment depending on file size.



Close iMove.



The following instructions can be modified for your own student projects, however; steps 1,2,5,6 are necessary for placing files into WebDav, otherwise, point to your desired folders for collection and access.

<p>1</p> <p>For this APHW project, you will follow these directions: Find & select the WebDavNav+ icon on your iPad</p>	
<p>2</p> <p>Open to your School Drives</p>	
<p>3</p> <p>Select the Drives S@STUSHARED</p>	
<p>4</p> <p>From STUSHARRED Select APHG</p> <p>Open your Period Folder 1 or 4</p>	
<p>5</p> <p>From WebDavNav+ bottom toolbar, choose the picture icon --</p>	
<p>6</p> <p>Select your movie from Camera Roll: allow to load:</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div style="width: 30%;">  </div> <div style="width: 30%;"> <p>After files has loaded, select using a long-hold on the file you want, then select “Play”</p> </div> <div style="width: 30%;"> <p>Currently, free options are short supply for playing your .mov files from your iPad, but you can Load from App Store the <u>Free Video Download</u></p>  </div> </div> <div style="margin-top: 10px;">   </div>
